1. Read Luke 3:1-6. What do we learn about John here?

Who all is mentioned? Do we know anything about anyone else mentioned here? Why do you think it matters that Luke uses all of their names? (Think back to Luke 1:1-4)

2. Read Luke 3:7-8. Why does John bring up Abraham, in this context? What is his point?

What things do people trust today to save them, rather than turning to Jesus?

3. List other passages from the Bible that you can think of which talk about the fruits of repentance. What does this mean?

4. List the 3 specific examples of fruits of repentance given in Luke 3:10-14.

Which of these 3 examples do you think was the most difficult for the original audience to hear?

Which of these 3 is the most difficult for you to live out? Why?

5. Luke 3:18 says that John was preaching the gospel. How does his message line up with the "gospel" of Jesus that we understand in full today? What does it show you about how you need to live? What needs to change, for you?
