1. How often has your daily Bible reading been exactly relevant for that day? Can you give examples?

2. Read Luke 4:14-21. How was this passage a perfect presentation of Jesus, at that time? What descriptions of the Messiah here stand out to you?

3. During His ministry, Jesus stressed that the good news is for the “poor” (see also Luke 7:22). Why does He say this?

4. Why do you think Jesus was rejected by the crowd? Look at Luke 4:22-30 and find any specific things that might explain their rejection. What implied reasons for their rejection are there as well?

5. What are some reasons people reject Jesus today? Think about both people who are “secular” as well as those who are “spiritual” as you think of answers.

6. What is it about Jesus’ message that you are most likely to reject? In what ways can you tend toward self-importance, rather than recognizing your own brokenness?

Share openly any struggles and situations and pray for healing in the midst of the brokenness of life.
