1. Have you ever seen someone exhibit great faith through a difficult time? Describe the situation. What were the evidences of their faith, during difficulty?

2. Read Luke 7:1-10. What evidences of faith do you see in the centurion's life and behavior?

What was it that caused Jesus to marvel at his faith?

3. Read Luke 7:16-19. Why do you think John was pondering this specific question? What expectations do you think John had that were not being met?

Read Jesus' response in Luke 7:22-28. Why do you think Jesus didn't condemn John's doubt? What do you learn from how Jesus speaks of John? What did John do right here?

4. Read Luke 7:31-35. In what ways does the world today try to get us to "dance to its tune"? When might the world mourn and we rejoice? When might it rejoice and we mourn?

To what extent should a Christian expect their behavior to be misinterpreted by the world?

5. Jesus points out the virtues of becoming like little children (Matthew 18:3). However, we're also warned not to be childish and immature (Luke 7:31-32, and see also 1 Corinthians 13:11 and Ephesians 4:14). Can you explain the distinction between these two approaches? Give examples.

Pray for the needs of each group member as you close your time together, praying specifically for any difficult situations where extra faith is needed.
