1. Read Luke 6:20-49 together. What sections would you break this sermon into?

What main themes do you see?

2. According to verses 20-23, who is “blessed”? What qualities are highlighted here? What blessings are received for them?

Read verses 24-26. Define “woe”. Explain how each woe relates to a beatitude.

3. If someone were to say “Luke 6:27-36 teaches us to be doormats”, how should we answer?

In reading these words, are we more like the “sinners” described in verses 32-34 or like God in verses 35-36. How so? In what ways can we change to be more like God?

4. Would we give more generously if we really took Luke 6:38 to heart? Should we expect financial blessings in return, or might they come in another form.

5. Consider verse 43. Do we mistake doctrinal knowledge for “fruit”? What is the “fruit” we should be looking at?

Refer to verses 47-49. How does this relate to the discussion on fruit? What does this tell us about times of crisis?
