1. If you were to sum up today's world in one word, what would that word be?

How many of these words were negative? How many positive? Why do we have a more optimistic or pessimistic view of our world?

2. Read Luke 12:35-40. What things are compared to Jesus' return here? In what ways are they similar?

For over two thousand years, God has been preparing the church to be ready for Jesus' return. If believers in the first century had known that such a long period would pass before the second coming, do you think they would have been so zealous for the gospel? Do you feel anticipation for His return now?

3. Look at how the servants respond to the master's absence in Luke 12:42-48. How do the unfaithful servants respond (verse 45)? What are the particular dangers today?

How can we apply verses 47-48 to ourselves and our world today?

4. If you knew Jesus was returning in exactly 5 years, what things would you do differently in your life? What if you knew he was returning in exactly 1 month?

What do your answers here show you about your current life priorities?

5. Reflect on your life from an eternal perspective. Do any specific things stand out that need to change? Is there something you can share with your group and ask for their help in praying for you as you work on it?
